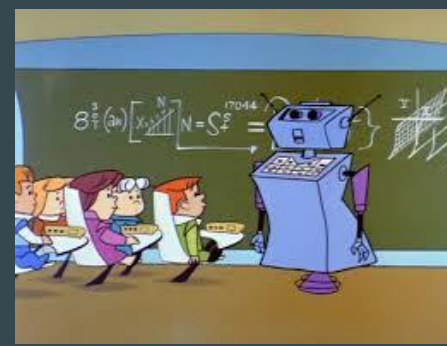

CANVAS –

- Canvas resources: training modules, consultation
- importing previous courses or course items

If the material already exists online, and it probably does, USE IT!

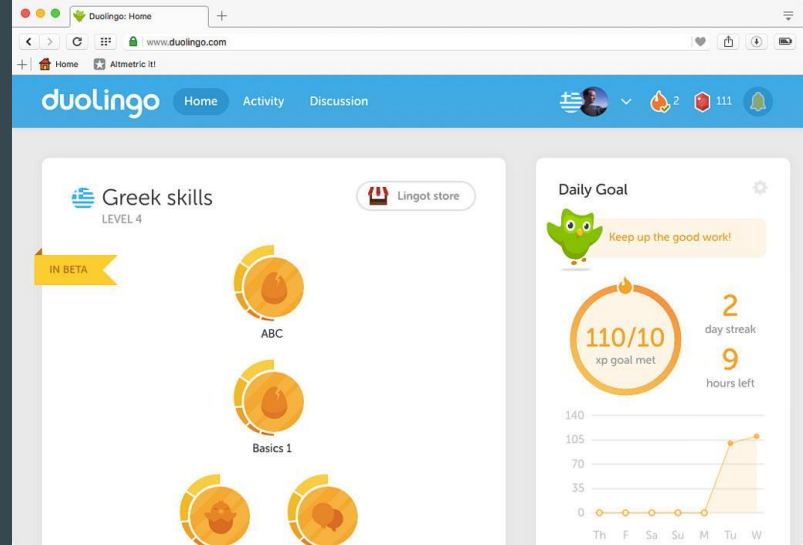

Running your online course

- Familiarize yourself with the tools
- First Day Attendance
 - Canvas Survey Tool or Discussion Board
- Go over how to use your site with your students
 - Introductory video or handout
- Check up on your students!
 - Message students who
 - Page views
 - Quiz diagnostics
- Discussion board posts - How do we make them engaging and not transactional?
 - Consider blog approaches, or non-canvas based spaces
 - Consider removing yourself from that space
- Robust feedback on papers and assignments

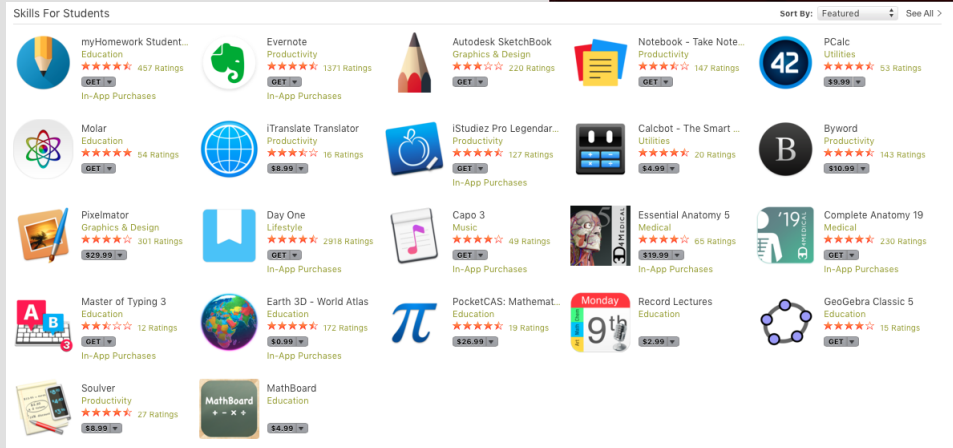
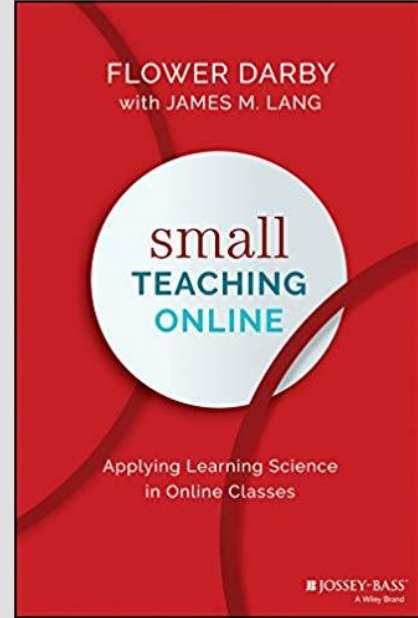
